I - Introduction

On the 27th day of March of two thousand and twenty-six, at 10 hours the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 18/02/2026, met by video conference, for the second meeting of the call Ref. CCMAR/BINCGAM/02/2026. The meeting was for the hiring of two Research Fellowships for a person with a Master Degree (Bolsa de Investigação não conducente à obtenção de grau académico para mestre), for applicants of any nationality, including stateless candidates, and holders of political refugee status, in the scientific field of **Aquaculture, Biology, Ecology, and other related fields** within the research project number **MPr-2023-7-18319** - named as **AQUADIVERSIFY: “Diversificação e Produção Sustentável em Aquacultura Multitrófica Integrada”** funded by Agência da Inovação. The jury present at the meeting was composed of Doctor Aschwin Engelen, Group Leader, Coordinator of the project and Auxiliary Researcher of CCMAR, Doctor Neusa Martins, Auxiliary Researcher at CCMAR (member); Doctor Tânia Aires Junior Researcher at CCMAR (member of the jury), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of the applications for the fellowship CCMAR/BINCGAM/02/2026.

V - Evaluation of applications

The Jury evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidates (**Table 2**) and applied the classification criteria and weighting factors set out in the vacancy announcement as shown in **Table 3** below:

Evaluation criteria and respective weighting:

1. Proven experience in the field of macroalgae culture maintenance/methodology and sporulation techniques – 40%
2. Proven experience with seaweed farming in hatchery, outdoor tanks, and open sea - 40%
3. Proven experience in the use of Excel, R, and PRIMER software and light microscopy – 20%

Note: The final grades in table 3 represent the average of the individual evaluation performed by each member of the jury, presented on a scale from **0** to **20**, rounded to the nearest tenth.

Table 4 presents the final classification.

The candidates **Aaron Johannes Cordes** and **Pedro André Magalhães** obtained the highest classifications (**Table 4**) and based on the elements presented in their applications, both meet the conditions for the purposes of eventual selection. Therefore, the Jury proposes the ratification of this decision to the CCMAR Board.

The Jury will proceed to the right of prior hearing, setting a deadline of 10 working days and gives candidates the right of recourse of the announced decision, whether in relation to scientific or procedural matters.
